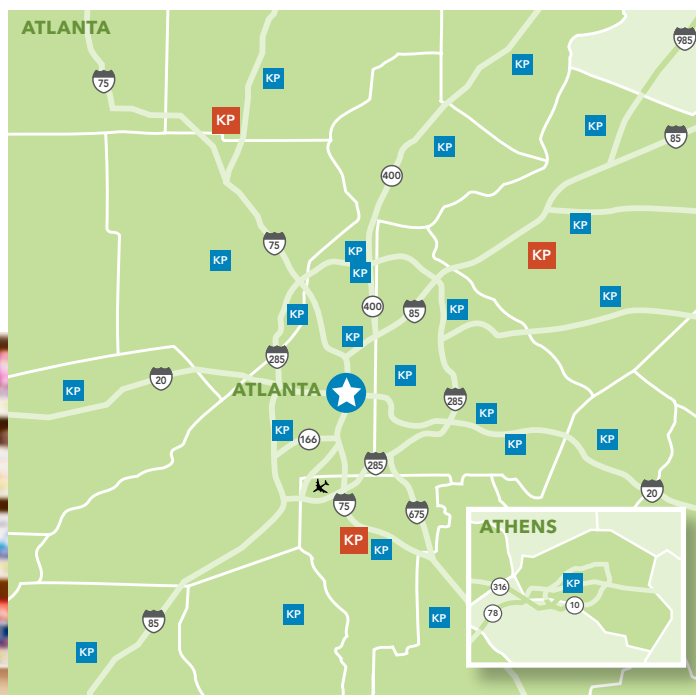

Two letters should be from rotation preceptors
