
Practice Setting



Our Mission

The Kaiser Permanente Napa Solano Residency Program is a one-year postgraduate program that provides training and experience in the provision of pharmaceutical care and pharmacy practice. The purpose of the Kaiser Permanente, Napa Solano pharmacy residency program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

Qualifications for Acceptance

- Graduate or candidate for graduation of an ACPE accredited college or school of pharmacy. (U.S. Schools of Pharmacy Only)
- Current California Intern License must be obtained before July 1st and in addition must obtain California pharmacist licensure by October 1st.

Application Requirements

- Curriculum Vitae
- Letter of intent
- Official transcripts
- Three letters of recommendations including questionnaire sent directly from the applicant's designee
- A sample of applicant's written work: either a published article or a presentation.

Resident Responsibilities

Residency Projects: Each resident will utilize a formal research or project management methodology to develop and implement a residency project. This project will culminate with a presentation of the results at the Western States Regional Residency Conference in San Diego, CA.

Continuing Education Seminar Series: Required to present a formal education seminar on a topic of their choosing.

Pharmacy Operations: Kaiser Permanente leadership meets regularly with the resident to involve them in the implementation of management programs and ensure exposure to various aspects of pharmacy administration. Additionally, residents are required to be active participants in the local pharmacy and therapeutics committee and other additional pharmacy committees per discretion of the residency director.

Teaching: Kaiser Permanente Napa Solano is affiliated with California Schools of Pharmacy and provides residents with the opportunity to precept students.

Regional and National Professional Development:
Residents participate in the Bay Area Residency Network (BARN). These meetings showcase the diversity of pharmacy roles within Northern California and allow residents an opportunity for professional networking. The California Society of Health-System Pharmacists (CSHP) Seminar, Western States conference, and the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting are also additional opportunities for professional development.
