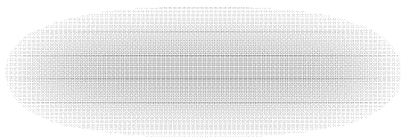


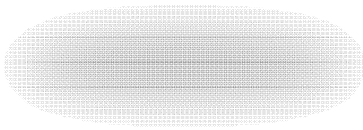
Preceptor bios

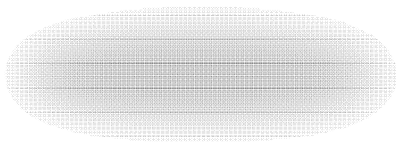
- **Background:**

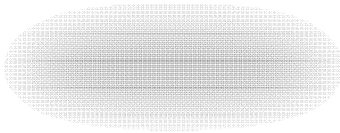
- **Background:**

- I currently precept the Hep/HIV elective rotation.

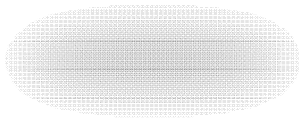
- **Why I Precept:**

Kelli Aoki, PharmD, BCPS



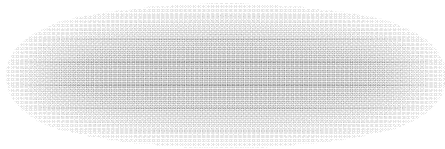
- **Background:**

Sinling Jennings



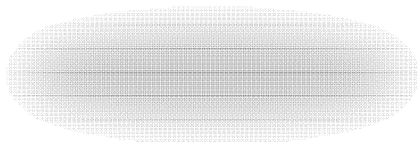
- **Background:**

Ivie Kumura



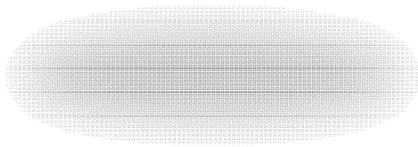
- **Background:**

Christine Kuroda



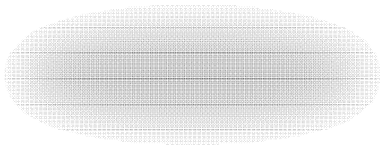
- **Background:**

Laura Lum



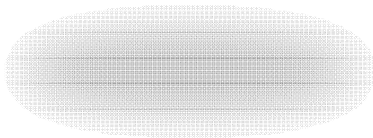
- **Background:**
