### Qualifications:

- Pharm.D. from an accredited school of pharmacy
- Eligibility for licensure in the state of California
- Excellent letters of recommendation
- Demonstrate motivation, strong written/verbal communication skills, solid-clinical foundation and creativity
- Complete application

### Application Materials:

(Phase 2 Deadline March 19, 2024)

- Letter of Intent
- Curriculum Vitae
- 3 Letters of Recommendation
- Official Transcript – Sent to directly to PhORCAS
