Qualifications

- Doctor of Pharmacy graduate from an accredited institution
- Must be licensed as a Pharmacist in the state of California by October 28, 2025 (120 days after start of residency)
- Current Curriculum Vitae, detailed to include clinical workshops taken (or planned) and pharmacy work experience
- Official transcripts, sent directly from the applicant's college or school of pharmacy
- Three (3) letters of recommendations
- Letter of Intent for the Residency Program

Dates to Remember

- **January 3rd, 2025** - Letter of interest, curriculum vitae and 3 letters of recommendation are due
- **February 2025** - Residency interviews
- **Early March 2025** - Deadline for residency ranking
- **March 2025** - Match results
